Encore Group Class Descriptions

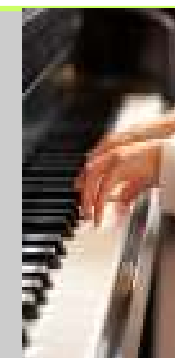
Musical Theater (beg)—Musical Theater offers the students a taste of singing, movement, and acting in a fun setting. Over the course of the semester, audition techniques are covered in addition to the “basics” of performing plus a wide exposure to age- appropriate Broadway repertoire. Performance at the end of the semester.

Musical Theater (int)– Have you performed in at least 2 of our full scale musicals or taken the musical theater beginning class for 2 sessions?. Do you have previous experience elsewhere? You have learned the basics and now we will strengthen your singing, dancing, and acting abilities to make you a true triple threat! Must have had previous performance experience and/or taken Musical Theater I at least twice.

Musical Theater (Adv)- This class is for the advanced performer to begin working on directing and blocking for their own scenes. The ensemble works collectively on one group number from a Broadway Musical, and 1-2 small group musical scenes with partners. Outside directors, teachers, and theater designers are brought in to give critiques and assistance. Performance at the end of the semester.

Acting— This class is for those who want to develop their acting skills without singing or dance. Students will work on partner scenes and monologues. Developing a strong character, learning stage blocking, and improvisation are the focus of this class.

Dance for Musical Theater– are you a performer who wants to strengthen your dance skills? This class will feature basics in jazz and tap, and will include repertoire from many different musicals. Single class drop-ins ok!
